LOCATION






The event will take place in the City of Naguanagua, Edo. Carabobo, in the center of the country 2 hours from Maiquetia International Airport (Caracas), with Arturo Michelena International Airport 15 minutes (8km) from the epicenter, a city that is part of the Greater Valencia, 2nd city in importance and industrial, which offers the optimal and attractive infrastructure to attend the event.

LOCATION OF TRACKS

The locations of the tracks for the 2 days of race are within the Municipality and are 3 km away and approximately 15 minutes by vehicle between one and the other, as well as the Accommodation options that are between the two. They have served as a stage for National Championships, Copa Venezuela and Pan American DH and Enduro for more than 20 years.




Bike Park Tazajal, Day 2 of the Race Sunday, October 12. (Coordenadas [10.251526, -67.990966](#))

TRACKS AND TRAILS

Day 1 of Carrera Cerro el Café, with more than 9 different Special Tests and 1 PWS (power stage) for both EDR (enduro) and Ebikes (E-Enduro) categories. Min altitude 590msnm Max alt. 1.211meters above the sea level






The UCI Elite categories will have 23 km and more than 1800 mts of accumulated ascent in the 4 special tests they carry out. Then the other categories will decrease according to their route. They will have assistance in some transition sections where we will have transport vehicles.

The Ebikes categories will not have assistance in transitions and will perform 1 more Special in the Elite cat in addition to the PWS1

The Host of day 1 of the race will be in the middle part of the mountain where we will have a closed park area, logistical support area, hydration area and technical table. There will also be logistical facilities for visitors and the general public.

Day 2 of Race Cerro Tazajal, with more than 7 different Special Tests and 1PWS for the different EDR and E-EDR categories. Min Cota 560msnm Max Cota 842 meters above the sea level





The UCI categories will have 16 km and more than 1100 mts of accumulated ascent in the 4 special tests they carry out. They will not have assistance in transitions just like Ebikes.

The Ebikes Elite categories will additionally perform 1 more Special in addition to the PWS2

The Host of day 2 of the race will be in the lower part of the mountain (Spiral Club Headquarters) where we will have a closed park area, a logistical support area, a hydration area and a technical table. There will also be logistical facilities for visitors and the general public.

It should be emphasized that we will have all the logistical support of Forest Firefighters, Civil Protection, Doctors, Ambulances, State Security Forces and logistics staff.

In turn, we will have the certified commissioners of the FVC in accompaniment of the Qualified Personnel sent by the COPACI.

TRAVEL VISA FOR ENTRY INTO THE COUNTRY

For countries that require VISA to enter Venezuela, the approval and granting of Electronic VISAS for all delegations, companions and technicians has been enabled in conjunction with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, in a process of approximately 15 working days, for which they must send the following requests:

- Valid Passport
- Personal data, address, phone, email, occupation.
- Event Registration and UCI License
- Letter from the Federation of the corresponding country.
- Name of the participant and previous data in case of being a companion.

All this will be processed on the same registration page, and the organization will be in charge of linking and managing the process and informing the applicants

Transportation

There will be Bus Transport options by the event from July 19 to 23 which will make the Ccs - Valencia route for participants who arrive in the country through the Int. Airport. Simón Bolívar de Maiquetía, additionally at the Arturo Michelena Airport in Valencia we will have transport by bus from the airport to the host hotels, on the same days. For the return on Monday, July 28, there will also be buses for transfers of athletes to both departure airports.

On the other hand, there are different vehicle rental options with the different agencies, vehicles with driver authorized by us and additionally taxi, ridery.





Climate

The climate is tropical and has two well-marked seasons of dry period (November - May) and the rainy period (May-November) where temperatures throughout the year vary between Min. 20 Degrees Celsius (66 Fahrenheit) and Max 36 degrees Celsius (97 Fahrenheit)

Currency

The official currency is the Digital Bolivar (Bs.) and the exchange rate is at 66 Bs/\$ per American dollar. All establishments accept payments in both Bolivars and US dollars and international cards.

Voltage

The common voltage is 120 V and frequency of 60Hz

MEDICAL CARE CENTERS

The city has a large number of Private Clinics and Hospitals equipped with all the needs at the time of any eventuality, where they even work with international insurers, in addition to the fact that in the registration of the event the athlete had a minimum coverage of attention. Among the centers we have:

- La Viña Polyclinic Center dist. 6 km
- Guerra Méndez Medical Center dist 7 km
- Metropolitan Hospital of the North, dist. 2km

Medical insurance will also be available for athletes who do not have it and can obtain it at a low cost.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Event will be opened on the date indicated by COPACI for the start of registrations, accommodation reservations, etc., through the organization's page www.enduroseriesvzla.com where you will find all the necessary information and the format, that is why:

- Complete the registration process (form and payment)





- The cost of event registration is \$130 USD per participant, which includes the competition kit with a bag, event jersey, participant number and identification, items from the different allies and the competition chip.
- All participants must have a UCI License issued by the country they represent and their federation.
- Each delegation must deliver a letter endorsed by its respective national federation with all its members, both delegates and athletes who will compete in the UCI categories.
- Each delegation and participant must pay and be responsible for their: tickets, accommodation, food, transportation, etc., in addition to having an accident policy in force.
- Each delegation must bring with it uniformity, flag, national anthem and comply with the UCI and COPACI standards in addition to those of the event organized by ESV and FVC.
- The modality will also be governed by the current UCI rules for enduro tests as well as the corresponding sanctions and anti-doping control. The equipment, protections and others must also comply with the entire regulation.
- Non-UCI categories must comply with all the above regulations.
- The Stages will be published on October 1st.
- During the days of practice there will be support in the transitions, which must be assumed by each participant.
- Sports fair play must reign, the sanctions for unsporting behavior will even be withdrawn from the event.
- Environmental standards must be met, we must take care of and protect the environment where we develop the skills. An environmental offense will be penalized.
- The times will be measured with a state-of-the-art electronic and intelligent system, where we will have live results during both days of testing, athletes and people of any kind will be able to enter the live app and follow the development of the race. The result of each day of competition will be immediately to the athlete to complete his test route.
- The event will have a delegation area and closed park and a commercial area for allies and sponsors.
